About the College



Government General Degree College, Chapra is a rural Undergraduate General College, situated at the outskirts of the village Shikra in the Chapra Block of Nadia district, approximately 3 km from India-Bangladesh International Border. Affiliated to the University of Kalyani, the college was established on 30-10-2013 and is one of the four newly constructed public colleges in the district of Nadia. The college is surrounded by enriched cultivated crop fields possessing both cultivated and wild crop relatives, naturalized and exotic flora and fauna of Indo-Bangladesh in origin, especially diversity of snakes attracting researchers in the field of herpetology to familiarize this rural-based remote and economically backward minority college to the global arena. The college will be a world biodiversity study centre in very near future.

About Biodiversity & Conservation Laboratory

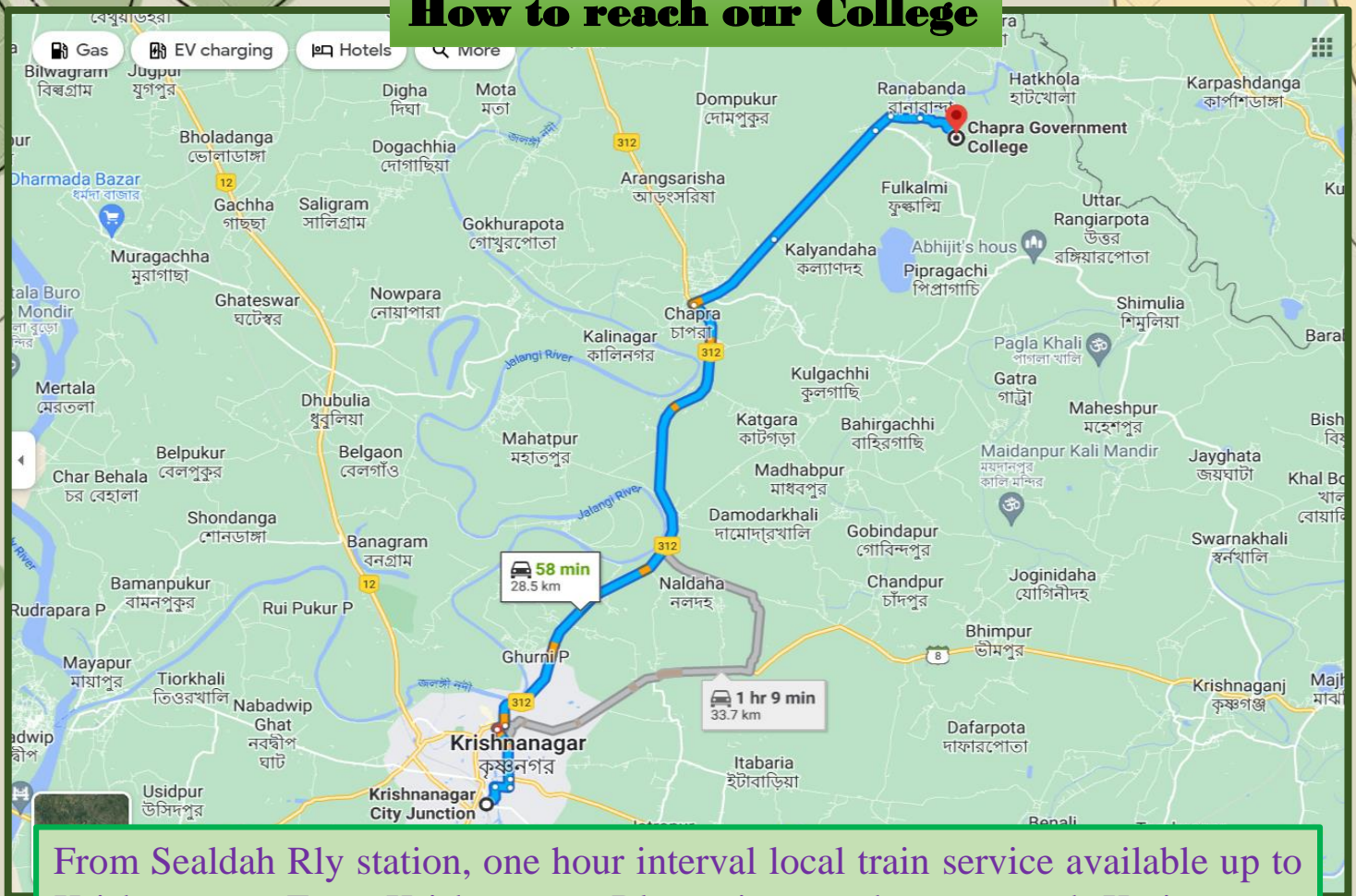

How to reach our College



From Sealdah Rly station, one hour interval local train service available up to Krishnanagar. From Krishnanagar Rly station you have to reach Karimpur or new bus stand by auto (Rs. 15/-) which are plenty. From Karimpur bus stand you have to catch express bus going to karimpur, and get down at Chapra Srinagar more, which is 1st stop (16 km: Rs. 20/-). From Srinagar more to College we will provide auto (14 km). Local people called Shikra College.

Note: we will provide high tea, lunch and evening snacks. From college to Chapra bus stand, we will provide auto daily. From Chapra to Krishnanagar, communication is cheapest and easily available.

For accommodation, participants are requested to arrange on their own. Good accommodation available at Krishnagar city [28 km from college]; GGDC, Chapra is a newly established college not having guest house or hostels yet. Please try to stay at Krishnanagar city near bus stop.
